Report

- 12-05-07 7:45 am Officer was called by a female resident about finding a marijuana pipe in her estranged husbands truck. Due to the circumstances on how the pipe was found, it will be held as evidence and no charges filed.
- 12-18-07 2:30 pm Officer took a report from a business owner about someone ripping half of his license plate off one of his work trucks. Unknown suspects. The plate was entered into the system if someone tries to use it and the owner of the vehicle was issued new plates.
- 12-20-07 10:51 pm Officer took a report from a female Cambridge resident about someone breaking her window out of her vehicle. Nothing was taken from the vehicle. A neighbor stated he saw two males, unknown age, were seen trying to pry on the trunk before police arrived. One was wearing a red winter coat. No one matching the description was located.
- 12-20-07 11:45 pm Officer took a report from a female Cambridge resident about two of her windows that were broke out of her vehicle while she was in a local business. No evidence found and nothing stolen from the vehicle.
- 12-21-07 11:30 am Officer took a report from a female Cambridge resident about some harassment from her neighbor. Statement taken and investigation continues.
- 12-27-07 12:30 am Officer arrested a 36 year old Des Moines female for OWI 1st. She was transported to jail.

Huxley Officers did have a busier year in 2007 for the City of Cambridge than 2006 in overall contacts. Here is a break down of some of the increases and decreases.

Arrests for the year went down 2 to 43. The number of citations issued were the same at 107 but warnings went up 10 to 155. Alcohol contacts went up 8 to 16 and this included 7 for OWI, 1 for public intoxication, 4 for possession of alcohol and 4 for open container.

Assaults were up 2 to 5. Burglary calls went up 1 to 8 and criminal mischief calls jumped from 1 in 2006 to 16 in 2007. Large in part to a group of kids in mid October that broke windows out of a couple of different places which lead to about 8 different charges.

Drug charges went up 2 to 5. But Domestic disputes dropped from 10 to just 5.

Calls for information or assistance went up by 182 to 303. The number of traffic accidents went up from 1 to 9.

The total number of contacts for the year went from 678 in 2006 to 931 in 2007. Huxley Officers had 134.75 hours of answering calls, giving assistance or investigations and gave 812.75 hours for patrol, up from 770.75 in 2006. Total number of hours spent in Cambridge for 2007 were 947.75, up from 872.5 in 2006.
