Report

- 01-01-08 1:05 pm Officer met with DHS to do a welfare check on a family because of living conditions. Inside the home, nothing was found to be unsafe. Nothing further.
- 01-06-08 4:36 pm Officer arrested a 60 year old Story City man for driving while revoked. He was taken to jail.
- 01-07-08 3:30 pm Officer took a report of a 13 year old Ballard student harassing another student while walking home from school. It was report that one of the students had a knife. After the investigation, no knife was in possession of either student. Both stated the other picks on them a lot and getting tired of it. Both students along with the parents were advised to stay away from each other and if something else happens that the kids are to tell the parents or school officials.
- 01-11-08 4:00 am Officer was called to a residence on 4<sup>th</sup> St about an alarm going off at the house. After the investigation, it appeared that someone may have tried to get into the house but was unsuccessful. The tracks of the possible suspect lead back north towards 5<sup>th</sup> St. No one seen in the area and no other calls.
- 01-13-08 11:24 pm Officer was called to a roll over accident on 315<sup>th</sup> St just west of the water tower. After the investigation, the 16 year old daughter, who was driving the vehicle home to Ames, lost control on the slick roadway and entered the ditch and rolled down into the field. She was taken to the hospital by her mother. The 16 year old and her mom were met with the next day to finish the report.
- 01-19-08 2:15 pm Officer was called to a possible domestic to a residence on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. After the officer arrived and the investigation was complete, there were stories that were inconsistent with one another but no signs of physical assaults. The male half of the party was asked to leave for the night to help things calm down, which he did. Nothing further.
- 01-19-08 4:57 pm Officer arrested a 28 year old Cambridge male for driving under suspension. He was cited and released with a court date.
- 01-21-08 9:00 am Officer was contacted by a female resident who claims to have had \$400 stolen from her purse sometime overnight. She stated that she had a couple of friends over to spend the night and each friend brought a friend. The female stated she has already talked with the suspects and was allowed to search their persons and apartment and found nothing. Report made and under investigation.

01-21-08 10:37 pm Officers were called to a residence by a Cambridge male. Upon arrival, the male stated that he was assaulted by his 16 year old step grandson. The male did not want charges filed but wanted him out of his house. The parents of the 16 year old were contacted and advised to pick up the property from the house. Nothing further.

01-25-08 5:00 pm Officer was called by the parent of a juvenile male. She stated that her son was assaulted by being shot with a air soft gun pellets. After the investigation, two 14 year old Cambridge boys admitted to shooting the other kid but insist they were just playing. Both 14 year olds were charged with assault.

01-27-08 7:30 Officer took a call from a resident in the Cambridge apartments about some kids that keep knocking on her door and yelling profanities. The officer spoke to the two juvenile boys involved and also the parents and advised if anymore happened, charges will be filed.

Huxley officers had 4 arrests for the month. 2 for assault, 1 for DWR and 1 for DUS. Officers issued 16 traffic citations and gave 31 warnings. Officers had 24 calls for information or assistance and a total of 108 contacts. Officers had 8.75 hours for answering of calls or giving assistance and 89.75 hours of patrol.
