- 02-17-08 3:28 pm Officer was contacted by a female Cambridge resident about her soon to be ex sister in law, calling and harassing her. A report was made and contact was made by the female suspect in Nevada. She was told to make no more contact or charges could be filed. No other calls have been taken since this report.

- 02-19-08 4:30 pm Officer assisted a Hardin Co Deputy on a search warrant of a residence in Cambridge where two juvenile males were suspected in a robbery of a store in Hardin Co.
- 02-27-08 3:25 pm Officer arrested a 25 year old Cambridge man for driving under suspension. Cited and released with a court date.
- 02-27-08 9:40 pm Officer arrested a 49 year old Cambridge man for OWI 1<sup>st</sup>. He was also charged with Harassment of a Public Official, possession of paraphernalia and 3 traffic charges. Taken to jail.

Huxley Officers had 5 arrests for the month. They were 2 for OWI, 1 for driving under suspension, 1 for harassment and 1 for possession of paraphernalia. Huxley Officers issued 6 traffic citations and gave 8 warnings. Officers had 34 calls for assistance or information and a total of 89 contacts for the month. Officers had 11.5 hours of giving assistance, answering calls or investigations and 68.5 hours of patrol.
