Report

- 08-02-07 1:00 pm Officer was called to an assault at a residence in New Horizons mobile home court by the 18 year old male victim / resident. The male stated that he was assaulted by a 21 year old Ames male and friend of the family. The 18 year old was transported to Mary Greeley by family and refused to have charges filed against the 21 year old.
- 08-03-07 1:20 am Officer arrested a 24 year old Indianola male for driving under suspension. He was cited and released with a court date.
- 08-03-07 9:45 pm Officer took a report of a fraud from a resident of National Dr. Apartments. The female had been doing some on-line chatting with a male in California. He asked if she would mail some packages to Nigeria. The female did receive several packages from Old Navy. The female refused delivery and the packages were sent back to the company. The fraud is connected with stolen credit card numbers and is under investigation.

The 9 year old had taken a skateboard and struck the other 9 year old in the head while he was riding by on his bike. After falling from his bike the 9 year old defendant kicked the 9 year old in the ribs. The 9 year old defendant was placed on house arrest and can only go outside with his parents or other responsible adult.
- 08-29-07 8:17 pm Officer took a report from a Huxley teenager that his red NEXT Flat Spin stunt bike with rear pegs, was stolen outside of Park Place apartments. Under investigation.
- 08-29-07 9:15 pm Officer took a report from a BHS cheerleading coach of some criminal mischief done to some of the cheerleaders vehicles. She stated that in the last 3 days, someone has sprayed some sort of sticky substance on the vehicles, some sort of liquid poured on the vehicles and in one instance, raw meat left on the vehicle. Unknown suspects and under investigation.
- 08-30-07 11:05 pm Officer investigated a two vehicle accident at 1st St and Hwy 69. A Waukee male had failed to see a vehicle driven by a Slater man was stopped due to traffic and struck the rear of his vehicle. Approximately \$5,500 total damage. No charges.

Huxley Officers made 29 arrests for the month. 5 for driving under suspension, 5 for public intoxication, 5 for OWI, 4 assault, 2 disorderly conduct, 2 interference with official acts, 1 for driving while revoked, 1 for a domestic assault, 1 for possession of alcohol, 1 for eluding, 1 for reckless driving and 1 for a warrant.

Officers issued 47 citations for traffic violation and gave 113 warnings for the same. Officers had 162 calls for information or assistance and a total of 524 contacts for the month. Officers had 275.75 hours for answering of calls, giving assistance or investigations and 605.5 hours of patrol.
