Report

- 02-02-08 5:00 pm Officer took a report from a Ballard High student about his vehicle having a window broke out of it sometime during the day between 7 am and 5 pm. A pair of black Nike basketball shoes were taken. Under investigation.
- 02-02-08 11:28 pm Officers were called to a residence about a 41 year old man that was contemplating suicide. The officers were able to talk the man into going to MGMC for evaluation.
- 02-03-08 10:08 pm Officer took a report of possible vandalism to his vehicle and also harassing phone calls. The male, a 18 year old BHS student believes the incidents are related but unknown for sure who is doing it. Several people that he thought were suspects were checked out. Under investigation.
- 02-04-08 12:24 pm Officers were called to the Ballard Medical Clinic for a 70 year old female who had collapsed. The female passed away and the cause of death was determined to be natural causes.
- 02-07-08 3:30 pm Officer met with a BHS teacher to report that her windshield was cracked and she didn't believe the crack was there when she came to school. Unknown how the crack was made. No evidence of anything suspicious.
- 02-08-08 2:15 pm Officer was given a bad check written to the City of Huxley by a builder. The builder was contacted the check was taken care of.
- 02-08-08 4:15 pm Officer was contacted by a resident about someone using his ATM card information and making over \$1200.00 in purchases, all out of state. The bank cancelled the card information and the male was not held liable. The bank will contact the PD if any information becomes available.
- 02-08-08 5:00 pm Officer was contacted by Management of someone living in a trailer that was supposed to have been out a month ago. The officer went to the trailer with the manager and found a 28 year old Cambridge male living in the trailer still and also found him smoking marijuana at the time of the investigation. The male was arrested for trespass, possession of marijuana and paraphernalia and taken to jail.
- 02-08-08 5:30 pm Officer was called to a residence on Meadow Cr. where a 13 year old was fighting with his siblings and Grandmother. The boy was talked to until his Aunt came home from work. No charges at this time will be filed.

- 02-10-08 3:45 am Officer stopped a 19 year old Huxley man for a traffic violation on Hwy 69. The male had been drinking and blew over .02 but not over .08, the legal limit. The .02 violation was invoked on the male and driving privileges will be suspended by the DOT.
- 02-10-08 5:50 pm Officer took a call of a 1 vehicle accident at Parkridge and Meadow Ln. A 36 year old Huxley female, due to the icy conditions, slid trying to turn the corner and broke a stop sign post. No other damage to vehicle. No report and no charges.
- 02-10-08 6:30 pm Officer covered a 2 vehicle accident at the 104 mm northbound I35.
- 02-11-08 5:00 pm Officer took a report of a possible violation of a no contact order. A statement was taken by the female reporting party and also the male party in the matter was spoken to as well as his brother who was acting as a mediator. All the information was obtained and sent to the Co Atty for review. The Co Attorney who enforces the no contact orders stated that no violation had occurred and no charges will be filed.
- 02-12-08 10:00 am Officer took a report from a male Huxley resident, a local contractor, about his storage unit being broken into. Approximate loss of tools taken was \$1920.00. Because of the deductible amount on the insurance policy, it was not going to be turned in to insurance.
- 02-13-08 11:40 am Officer arrested a 16 year old BHS student for kneeing another student in the stomach. The 16 year old stated he was just messing around. The male was charged with simple assault and taken to Juvenile Court office per the request of the probation officer. The 16 year old was already on probation for burglary charges last fall.
- 02-18-08 9:30 pm Officer took a report from a male Huxley resident about someone hitting his vehicle. The male had lost control of his vehicle due to the icy roads and put his vehicle in the ditch just south of town on Hwy 69. Because of a tow ban on the highways, it was left there. When the male came back around 9:30 pm, someone else had entered the ditch, hit his vehicle and did over \$1,000 damage. That person was able to get out of the ditch and drove away. Unknown who did it.
- 02-20-08 4:07 pm Officer arrested a 41 year old Harford man for driving under suspension. Cited and released with a court date.
- 02-21-08 8:01 am Officer covered a 2 vehicle accident at E 4th and N 1st. A female Ballard student slid through the stop sign due to the road conditions and struck a vehicle being driven by a female Cambridge female. Total damage was estimated at \$2,000 and no citations due to road conditions.

- 02-21-08 10:00 am Officer took a bad check from a Huxley business in the amount of \$192.80. A ten day notice was sent to the female Huxley resident who wrote the check.
- 02-21-08 9:15 pm Officer took a report from a female Huxley resident about credit card fraud. Someone in the Dallas, Texas area had used her name and credit card info to place an ad in a paper for a used car for sale. The credit card company was contacted the charges dismissed and card cancelled.
- 02-23-08 12:17 am Officer was called to an apartment for a domestic assault. After doing some investigation, the 22 year old male party was arrested and charged with serious Domestic Assault and taken to jail.
- 02-23-08 9:30 pm Officer arrested a 16 year old Ames female for public intoxication and disorderly conduct. She was taken to MGMC because of her level of intoxication and then turned over to her mother. Referrals were sent to juvenile court.
- 02-28-08 3:49 am Officers were called to a vehicle in the ditch south of town on Hwy 69. The 35 year old Des Moines man was uninjured but unresponsive due to his intoxication. He was taken to MGMC for blood to be drawn for a possible OWI. Charges pending until lab work is back.
- 02-29-08 2:54 pm Officer was called to a resident where a male Huxley resident claimed to be assaulted by his girlfriend. Statements were taken from both the male and female parties in the relationship. The info was sent to the Story Co Atty office for review. Possible charges pending.

Huxley Officers made 11 arrests for the month. They were 3 for possession of alcohol under age, 1 narcotic violation, 1 paraphernalia possession, 1 .02 violation, 1 assault, 1 driving under suspension, 1 domestic assault, 1 public intox and 1 disorderly.

Officers issued 49 traffic citations and gave 110 warnings for various traffic offenses. Officers received 179 calls for assistance or information and had a total of 518 contacts for the month. Up from 364 the month before. Huxley Officers had 221.5 hours of answering calls, giving assistance or investigations and 382 hours of patrol.
