Report

- 06-03-08 2:00 pm Officer responded to a call of a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival, the Officer found that a husband and wife had been arguing but nothing physical had taken place. After speaking with the both of them, both parties agreed to work things out.
- 06-03-08 8:40 pm Officer received a call about a theft. Speaking with the victim, he stated that his roommate had a friend stay overnight and the next morning, found his \$240 was taken from the residence. The victim thought that the suspect lived in Maxwell. After having Deputies check the possible residence, it was learned that the suspect has moved and it is unknown where he is. Under investigation.
- 06-05-08 9:20 am Officer took a complaint about a semi driver pulling onto private property and the semi leaked a large amount of coolant on the parking lot, then drove off and left the mess. Company officials were able to get a plate number and the semi company was contacted. Arrangements were made between both companies to get the mess cleaned up.
- 06-05-08 3:15 pm Officer took a complaint about a possible assault. After the investigation, it was learned that nothing had taken place.
- 06-05-08 12:30 pm Officer took a complaint about a fight that took by the bike racks at school place after summer school classes were let out. The 12 year old victim stated he was punched by another 12 year old boy. During the investigation, it was unclear of who exactly started it. Both boys were talked with along with parents. School Administration will handle any discipline.
- 06-06-08 5:00 pm Officer took a report from a resident about purchases that had been made on his credit card but not by him. The victim called the credit card company and had the charges removed and was found not responsible for the purchases.
- 06-09-08 5:25 pm Officer took a report of a young juvenile running into a parked vehicle with his bike and doing some damage. The owner of the truck and the father of the young boy talked and agreed to handle this between them selves.
- 06-11-08 7:30 pm Officer took a report from the manager of New Horizons about wanting somebody removed from the property. A 19 year old Ames boy who has had complaints called on him about loud music and such several times, was trespassed from the property and told that if he does return, he could be charged.

- 06-14-08 1:48 am Officer stopped a vehicle on Hwy 69 for a traffic violation and found the 18 year old Ankeny boy to have been drinking alcohol. He was tested and found to be in violation of the .02 law. No criminal charges and parents came to pick him up.
- 06-14-08 4:20 pm Officer arrested a 18 year old Huxley boy for driving under suspension. He was cited and released with a court date.
- 06-16-08 2:23 am Officer arrested a 51 year old Madrid man for OWI 1st. He was taken to jail.
- 06-17-08 4:30 pm Officer took a report of damage to a vehicle. A garbage truck had picked up a dumpster that was filled with trash. While driving down the street, a large wooden crate fell out and struck the back window of a minivan and broke it. The van is owned by a Huxley couple. The owners of the van were notified and the garbage truck company's insurance will take care of the damages.
- 06-18-08 7:30 pm Officer arrested a 34 year old Huxley man for child endangerment and disorderly conduct. The man was intoxicated and pushed his stepson to the ground and kicked the family dog. He was taken to jail.
- 06-23-08 7:07 am Officer arrested a 22 year old Des Moines man for driving under suspension. He was cited and released with a court date.
- 06-24-08 12:44 am Officer arrested a 34 year old Huxley man for driving under suspension. He was cited and released with a court date.
- 06-24-08 5:10 am Officers were called to a vehicle fire. The case is still under investigation along with the other vehicles that were entered and some items stolen because they were left unlocked in the driveway's of people's residences.
- 06-27-08 2:14 pm Officer investigated a 2 vehicle accident in the parking lot of 3Cs. Two people backing out of parking spaces at the same time and did not see each other. Total damage estimated at \$750. Report made, no citations.
- 06-28-08 1:52 am Officer arrested a 20 year old Milo man for OWI 1st. Taken to jail.
- 06-30-08 11:30 am While investigating an incident which occurred earlier in the month, Officer discovered that a suspect in the new incident gave false information, wrong name, date of birth and SS #, when arrested on another offense in February. Charges have been filed but the arrest is on hold until the current investigation is complete.

Huxley Officers made 10 arrests for the month of June. Two OWI and one .02 violation, three for driving under suspension, 1 for child endangerment, 1 for disorderly contact, 1 for false information and 1 warrant served. Huxley Officers issued 37 citations for traffic offenses and gave 86 warning for various others. Officers had 198 calls for information or assistance and a total of 476 contacts for the month. Officers had 344.5 hours of answering calls, giving assistance and investigations. Officers had 442.5 hours of patrol.
