

**Huxley Police Department**

**Report**

- 01-02-07 8:00 am Officer took a report from a the owner of Kreg Tool about someone stealing a flatbed trailer from the parking lot of his business. Value was \$1400.
- 01-03-07 9:28 pm Officer took a report from a Alleman female that she believes that her purse was taken out of her vehicle while she was at the Whistle Stop Daycare. Unknown suspects.
- 01-04-07 1:30 pm Officers received a report from a Jr High student about possible child abuse. The case was investigated and no evidence of abuse but the family was turned over to DHS for assistance.
- 01-04-07 3:45 pm Officer arrested a 38 year old Nevada man for a warrant out of Linn Co for theft 3<sup>rd</sup>. Taken to jail.
- 01-05-07 9:45 am Officer received a report from Huxley Regency management that 3 unoccupied trailers owned by the company had been broken into and items stolen from them such as water heaters, toilets and etc. No suspects.
- 01-06-07 4:55 pm Officer took a report from a Huxley male that after he had driven to Maxwell, he noticed that his brakes were failing him and thinks someone had cut his brake lines while the vehicle was parked in Park Place apt. parking lot. No suspects.

- 01-13-07 12:50 am Officer was called to a vehicle accident where a 22 year old Gladbrook man had driven his car off of the street and collided with a house. The 22 year old was arrested for OWI and taken to jail. Damage to the house was estimated at \$5,000 and the 2001 Chevy Monte Carlo was totaled. Taken to Story Co Jail.

No serious injury occurred to the male student but he did have several puncture wounds on his hand and back. Medical treatment was refused.

01-26-07 10:00 am Officer received a call about a two vehicle accident that had happened at

and Hwy 69. The drivers of both vehicles had exchanged information and then left the scene. No accident report made.

01-26-07 8:55 pm Officer took a report of a teenaged male coming into the Video Store naked with only a baseball cap and sunglasses on. The male did not make any comments nor make any sexual gestures and left the store when asked. During this investigation, it was learned that it was part of a video taped practical joke. Charges are still pending.

01-29-07 2:50 pm Officer investigated a one vehicle accident that occurred on Hwy 69 just north of the Country Club. A 20 year old Madrid female was northbound on the highway and lost control due to the ice covered road caused by blowing snow. The vehicle entered the ditch, through a fence and came to a stop in the field. No charges or injuries and approximately \$1500 damage to the truck and \$250 to the fence.

01-31-07 4:24 pm Officers took a report of possible sexual abuse on a juvenile female by a juvenile male. Under investigation.

01-31-07 8:12 pm Officer covered a two vehicle accident at the intersection of

Cambridge female was trying to stop at the stop sign and slid through the intersection and struck a trailer being towed by a truck that was headed south bound. No injuries or charges.

Huxley Officers had 18 arrests for the month. 1 OWI, 2 for assault, 1 for criminal mischief, 2 drug or paraphernalia charges, 1 disorderly conduct, 8 for sexual assault, 2 for DUS and 1 for theft. Officers issued 46 traffic citations and gave 78 warnings. Officers had 161 calls for information or assistance and a total of 445 total contacts for the month. Officers had 17 hours of on call, 370.5 hours of the answering of calls or assistance, 484.25 hours of patrol and 22.5 hours of investigations.
